Definition and duration of internship/thesis activities at the Department CIBIO

Approved by the Board of the CIBIO Department updated on July, 25th 2018

Whereas:

the internship regulations of the three study courses offered by the Department stipulate that "the internship is limited in time" and that "may start the placement students who have obtained at least":

DEGREE	CFUs
Bachelor's degree	120
Master of science BCM	60
Master of science QCB	48

- the number of credits assigned to internship (6) 6 the same for the 3 courses of study;
- the final examination (thesis) 6 usually associated with the internship activity;
- the credits dedicated to the final exam are:
 - 6 for the Bachelor of Science
 - 24 for the Master of Science CMB (30 starting from a.y. 2019/2020)
 - 15 for the Master of Science QCB.

The Board of the CIBIO sets the maximum duration of the internal traineeship/thesis period at:

Master of science BCM	7
	(9 months starting from the a.y. 2019/2020)
Master of science QCB	5

More extended internship/thesis periods may be considered in the following cases:

- a. early start of the internship/thesis period:
 - |||UNTRANSLATED_CONTENT_START|||lo studente deve <u>essere e rimanere alla pari con tutti gli esami</u> previsti dal proprio piano di studi durante il periodo di tirocinio/tesi. |||UNTRANSLATED_CONTENT_END|||If the student is not up to date with all the examinations but has already started the placement, the placement will be interrupted to allow them to make up the missing examinations;
 - Under no circumstances may the placement begin before September of the final year of the course of study.
 - It should be noted that the maximum duration of the traineeship remains unchanged.
- b. extension of the internship/thesis period:
 - if one or more objectives of the placement/thesis project are not met for technical or logistical reasons, the duration of the placement may be extended, once only, by:
 - weeks for the Bachelor of Science STB;
 - 6 weeks for the Master of Science BCM (7 weeks starting from a.y. 2019/2020)
 - 4 weeks for the Master of Science QCB.

The request for an early start or extension of the placement/thesis period is delivered by the tutor to the secretariat of the Centre for Integrated Biology using the appropriate form.
